

Hall County Sheriff's Office Now Hiring for Lateral Deputy Sheriff / K-9 Handler

The Hall County Sheriff's Office is currently accepting applications for the position of Lateral Deputy Sheriff to fill the position of K-9 Handler. Applicants must meet the following requirements: Currently certified in Nebraska or have a break in service of no more than two years. 21 years old by date of appointment, high school graduate or equivalent, good driving record with the ability to obtain a valid Nebraska Driver's License. Must also pass written, oral, physical fitness and psychological exams, drug screening, and a thorough background investigation to include a polygraph exam. Must be able to pass all entry requirements of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center. Experience working as a K-9 handler is preferred but not required.

On the recommendation of the Sheriff, certified hires who have a least one (1) year of continuous, full time experience as a law enforcement officer in the State of Nebraska, may be approved to begin employment at a pay scale higher than step 1 on the Deputy Sheriff's pay scale. The recommendation will be based on the applicants current base salary. The applicant will not receive any additional credit for seniority or leave time. Applicant will participate in the Field Training Program and have to complete a probationary period.

Wages are on a 9 step pay scale: 27.66 to 35.37 per hour and comes with a complete Benefit Package. Hall County is EOE and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age or disability in employment or provision of services. Veteran's preference is available.
