

Mental Health Practitioner

The Hall County Department of Corrections is seeking a full time mental health practitioner to provide mental health services for individuals detained at our facility. Provisionally licensed practitioners (PLMHP) are strongly encouraged to apply. The position works under the direct supervision of a fully licensed practitioner/coordinator (LIMHP) to provide a variety of mental health services including counseling, assessments, crisis and behavioral intervention to detainees, based on their need. Ideal applicants should be willing to treat detainees who have a variety of mental health issues including severe mental illness, suicidal thoughts, trauma, and substance abuse. This position supports and collaborates with Department of Corrections staff and on-site medical staff to ensure that mental health needs are identified and treated. Hall County offers competitive pay as well as benefits that included paid vacation, holidays and medical leave.
